

Guide for Faculty and Staff Responding to Student Reports of Sexual Misconduct

CARE

Care for the student

- Is the student physically safe?
- Does the student need medical care?
- Listen without judgment

You could say:

“I am sorry that this happened.”

“Do you feel safe now?”

“Do you want to see a doctor?”

“I am glad you are telling me.”

“I can give you information about resources on campus and off campus if you would like to talk to someone in confidence about this.”

CONNECT

Connect the student with resources

- Emergency – Police (911) and University Public Safety (617-349-8888)
- Online list of resources – on campus and off campus
- Online list of confidential and private resources

You could say:

“There are people and places you can reach out to for support.”
